

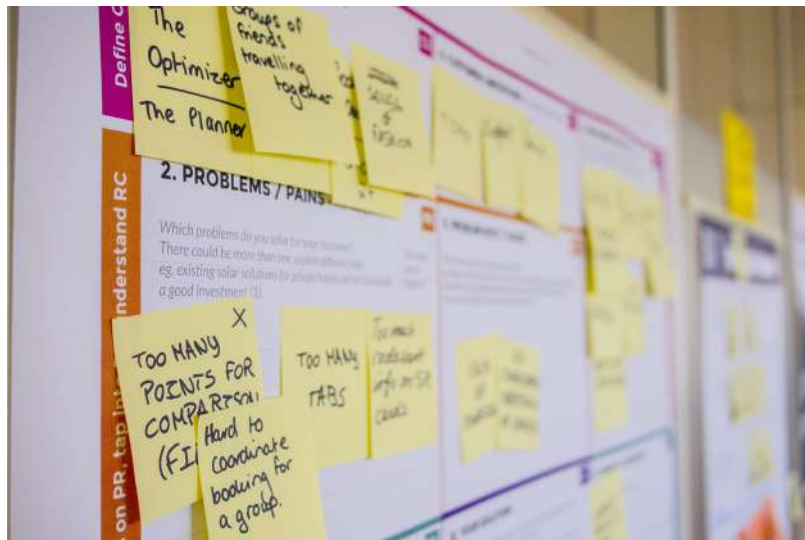


School Starters' Hub
